This year the topic will be "Library Services Transforming Library Spaces" with the seminar discussing how libraries are responding to evolving service demands through small and large environmental or facility changes. The seminar will look at a variety of library types. Participants are invited to bring examples of changes that have been occurring at their own institutions for sharing during the discussions.

A special part of the day will be the luncheon from 11:45 a.m. - 1:45 p.m. to which you are encouraged to invite a library board member or institution administrator as your guest. During the luncheon, panelists will speak about the expected role, mission and future development of libraries from the perspectives of a college president who has just built a new library, a city manager involved in the approval of new construction, and a university president who approved a major remodeling project.

Our featured speaker for the event is Charles Forrest, Library Planning Officer, Emory University. Forrest has more than 25 years of experience in academic and research libraries and has served as library project manager for numerous construction and renovation projects.
