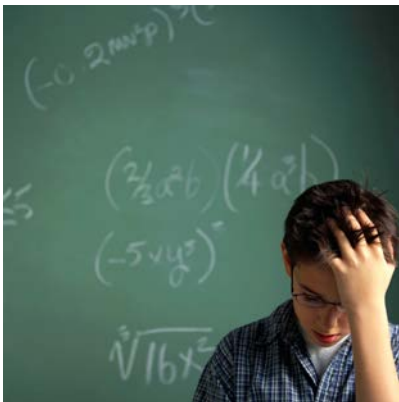
Honors is a verb: the Spring Community Engagement Challenge

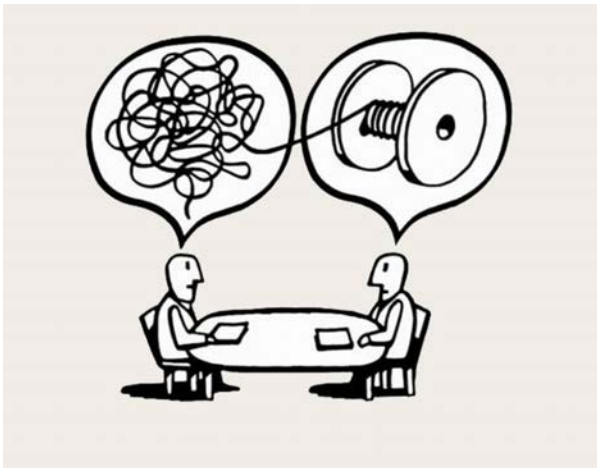

Faculty mentor: Jean Griffith, Associate Professor, English.

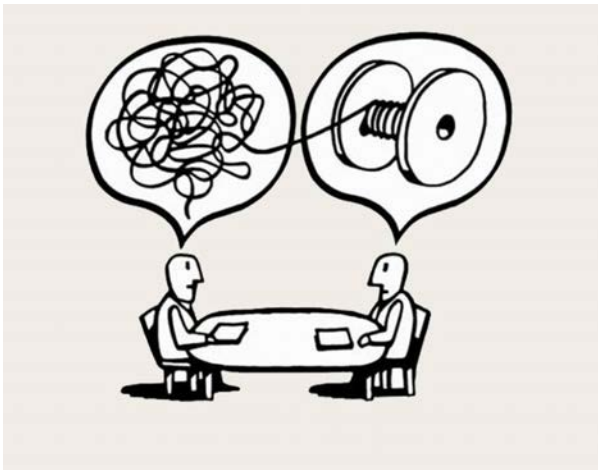
