ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE PRIORITIES AND GOALS

Division of Student Affairs

The Division of Student Affairs at Wichita State University responds to the needs of each student in a manner that encourages an enduring relationship of mutual support between the student and the university. The division is committed to providing a variety of programs, activities and services which facilitate access to the university; assisting students in the achievement of their educational goals; and providing learning experiences outside the classroom to enhance the academic pursuits of students.

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Divisional Overview

Student Affairs is involved and supportive of all phases of the higher education experience. The process begins with outreach, recruitment and admissions, then follows through the entire academic and campus life experience.

[Operations and Personnel](#) – oversees the day-to-day operations of the Division of Student Affairs.

[Campus Recreation](#) – offers a full range of fitness activities, competitive leagues for team sports, individual workouts, swimming, racquetball, weights and a variety of other activities.

[Child Development Center](#) – provides a comprehensive child care program for six-week to pre-kindergarten children, with a summer program for school age children. The services are for children of students, faculty and the public, utilizing education students as aides.

[Communication Upward Bound \(CUB\)](#) – serves students who want to pursue careers in all areas of communication and media relations.

[Counseling and Testing](#) – provides personal adjustment counseling, testing services and life skills training.

[Development and Fundraising](#) – Responsible for enhancing, creating and developing options for leadership scholarships, physical space needs and overall divisional growth.

[Disability Services](#) – coordinates compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) with students, faculty and staff aiding their unique requirements for accessing campus.

[Disability Support Services](#) – a TRIO program that provides tutoring, computer labs and advising services to disabled students.

[Diversity and Inclusion](#) – provides guidance and support to students, student groups and organizations with a look toward enhancing the multicultural experiences available on campus.

[Educational Opportunity Centers \(EOC\)](#) – a TRIO program that serves adult student population by assisting and / or preparing them to enter a post-secondary educational setting.

[Housing and Residence Life](#) – provides on-campus living accommodations and community learning opportunities with recent renovations and amenities to please every type of student.

[Kansas Kids @ GEARUP](#) – This grant is designed to serve foster care children in the state. Through a series of partnerships with state universities, community colleges, school districts and social service agencies, a variety of programs are provided to foster care children and those who serve them from elementary school through post-secondary education.

[McNair Scholars Program](#) – a TRIO program for students heading to graduate school, requires a match with faculty mentor, undergraduate research required.

North Wichita GEAR UP – a college access program that is federally funded through the U.S. Department of Education designed to help students prepare for post-secondary education.

Rhatigan Student Center – Key hub of the university, home of the National Championship Bowling Teams, University Bookstore, Campus Food Court and Student Leadership Offices. Central meeting place for all students and often a respite between classes.

South Wichita GEAR UP – a college access program that is federally funded through the U.S. Department of Education designed to help students prepare for post-secondary education

Student Conduct and Community Standards – Promotes a campus culture of respect and responsibility.

Student Engagement – focuses on enriching the experiences of students, faculty, staff and the greater community through programs, activities and services.

Student Government Association (SGA) – Student Affairs serves in an advising capacity to this student-run organization committed to student issues and concerns.

Student Health – offers primary health care for students, minor emergency services, health education and pharmacy services.

Student Involvement – oversees Greek Life, Student Activities Council, civic engagement, student organizations and leadership development.

Student Life – encompasses services to make campus life and activities available for all students.

Student Support Services – a TRIO program that offers tutoring to students and has a 90 percent success rate of improved grades.

Talent Search / Project Discovery – an education development TRIO program mentoring middle and high school students in preparation for college level work, assists with application process, financial aid, forms and ACT preparation.

TRIO Programs – a series of federally funded grant programs that provide services to students within certain guidelines.

Upward Bound Math / Science – a TRIO program that provides local high school students tutoring, preparation for college bound students, offers a two-month intensive on-site math / science camp.

Upward Bound Wichita Prep – a TRIO program that serves Wichita-area high school students by providing a bridge to college, structured Individualized Education Programs (IEP's), curriculum, testing and career workshops.

Veterans Upward Bound (VUB) – is a rigorous education and skills TRIO program designed to specifically meet the needs of today's veterans seeking a four-year degree. VUB prepares veterans for entering and successfully completing their degree in the institution of their choice.
