Members of the Planning and Budget Committee are elected each Spring by the incoming Faculty Senate.

The Senate President and President-Elect also serve ex officio.

PROCEDURES

- Attached is a nomination ballot for the Faculty Senate Planning and Budget committee. Two nominators are required for each person nominated. Please return nomination forms to the Senate Office (Box #111) by May 5. At the election meeting, May 10, additional nomination from the floor will also be accepted.
- The Planning and Budget Committee may not have more than one elected
 position filled from the same college or division. Therefore,
 nominees from Education and LAS Social Sciences are not permitted
 this year.
- 3. The following positions are available in this election:
 - 2 regular three-year terms (term expires Spring 1996)
 Terms expiring for Jolynne Campbell (CHP) and Dwight Murphey (BA)
 - 1 two-year term (term expires Spring 1995)
 Due to retirement of Glenn Fisher (AS) from WSU
 - 1 one-year term
 Due to resignation of Elmer Hoyer (ENG) from committee
- 4. Due to the restrictions on membership, a separate election will be held for each vacant seat, beginning with the longest terms. For each election, the eligible nominees will be those persons nominated from a college or division not yet represented on the committee. Before each election begins, an opportunity for additional nominations from the floor will be available.
- 5. Election requires a majority vote.
- Runoff elections will be held as necessary, with the number of nominees remaining in each runoff determined by a ruling of the Senate President, subject to challenge from the floor.
