**I. CALL OF THE MEETING TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by President Hawley at 4:35pm.

**II. PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** None

**III. ELECTION OF OFFICERS, EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, PLANNING AND BUDGET COMMITTEE:**

President Hawley asked for nominations for the position of President-Elect. Senator Bajaj nominated Senator Horn. Seconded by Senator Schommer. Senator Bajaj moved that nominations be closed and that Senator Horn be elected by acclamation. Seconded by Senator Eaglesfield. Senator Horn was elected President-Elect by acclamation.

President Hawley called for nominations for Vice President. Senator Bajaj nominated Senator Bair. Seconded by senator Burk. Senator Bajaj moved that nominations be closed and that Senator Bair be elected by acclamation. Seconded by Senator Eaglesfield. Senator Bair was elected by acclamation.

President Hawley called for nominations for Secretary. Senator Bajaj nominated Senator Eaglesfield. Seconded by Senator Bair. Senator Bajaj moved that nominations be closed and Senator Eaglesfield be elected by acclamation. Seconded by Senator Benson. Senator Eaglesfield was elected Secretary by acclamation.

President Hawley called for nominations for membership of the Executive Committee. Senator Baxter was nominated by Senator Coats. Seconded by Senators Fowler, Kraft and Matson. Senator Houts was nominated by Senator Benson and seconded by Senators Campbell and Hundley. Senator Hoyer was nominated by Senator Benson and seconded by Senators Paske, Terrell and York. Senator Horn moved that nominations be closed and that a paper ballot be taken. Seconded by Senator Eaglesfield. Ballot was distributed. Senators Coats and Horn were appointed tellers. Senators Hoyer and Houts made brief statements on their interest in serving. Senator Coats spoke on behalf of Senator Baxter who was not present due to River Festival rehearsals taking place at that time.

Senators Houts and Hoyer were elected.

President Hawley announced that she would appoint Senator Byrum to the Executive Committee.

President Hawley called for nominations to the Planning and Budget Committee. Two nominees were needed to represent Academic Services, LAS Humanities, LAS Social Sciences, and Business. It was required that only senators serve. Terms would be three years. Senator Brooks nominated Lawrence Davis from LAS Humanities. Senator Murphey nominated Douglas Sharp, to represent Business. Senator Matson moved that nominations cease and the two nominees be elected by acclamation. Seconded by Senator Hoyer. Senators Davis and Sharp were elected to the Committee.

President Hawley called for a vote of thanks to Past President Campbell. A vote was taken and applause was made.

Senator Swan moved adjournment. Seconded by Senator Hoyer.

The meeting adjourned at 4:55pm.
