New Auditing Option for the 2020-2021 Academic Year

The required move to online instruction in the spring of 2020 due to COVID-19 brought many challenges. Wichita State University is proud of the way our faculty rose to the task, providing the top-quality online instruction our university has delivered for many years.

As an additional benefit to our students, WSU has received approval by the Kansas Board of Regents to allow students who completed a

class in spring 2020 to audit the same class in fall 2020 or spring 2021, if offered, at no cost.

This will allow students to potentially be in-person for some course content and/or a chance to review that content. Audits can only be done in courses where space is available.

- Attendance in audit courses should not begin until after the audit enrollment is completed.
- Audit courses do appear on the academic transcript with a grade of AU, which has no impact on GPA. Audits carry no earned credit hours.
- Audited hours will not count toward the credit-hour requirements or be eligible for financial aid.
- Students who graduate prior to fall 2020 are not eligible for these audits.
- Students may audit at no cost in fall 2020 and spring 2021 only courses in which they were enrolled for normal credit in spring 2020.

How to audit a course from spring 2020

Students do not enroll in the audit courses using the normal registration system.

Enrollment in courses for audit can be done in person on the Thursday of the first week of each semester. For fall 2020, that date is Aug. 20; for spring 2021, Feb. 4, 2021. Students may also request an audit enrollment via email at registration@wichita.edu. **This email must come from the student's WSU email account.**
