Minutes of the adjourned meeting of February 3, 1975 (Vol. XI. No. 9)

- I. The meeting was called to order at 3:35 p.m. by President Camin.
- II. The Chair reviewed the motion which was before the Senate at the close of the meeting of January 27, 1975.
- V. Mr. Keith Graham discussed the previous motion and proposed the following four-part substitute motion:
  - (A) I move that the following motion be voted upon, Section by Section.
  - (B) I move that transfer students entering Wichita State University under the Kansas Public Community College Transfer and Articulation Agreement during the Summer Session, 1975, and the academic year 1975-1976 not be subjected to the 8 hour General Studies requirement;
  - (C) Further, I move that the Senate President be directed to appoint a representative Ad Hoc Committee to solicit and receive feedback from the WSU Admissions Office, various colleges and departments, and from Student Government Association, regarding potential problems which could arise with the implementation of the policy requiring 8 hours of General Studies courses for all types of transfer students;  
  
Further, also to solicit feedback from the University Committee for General Studies and others regarding potential benefits which could derive from implementation of said policy;
  - (D) Finally, I move that further action regarding implementation of the General Studies requirement for transfer students be delayed until the Ad Hoc Committee can report back to the University Senate, for further Senate discussion and action, but in no case later than the last scheduled meeting of the Senate in the Fall Semester of 1975.

Ms. Millett seconded.

a. Mr. Wix moved to amend the motion by striking in Section B "under the Kansas Public Community College Transfer and Articulation Agreement" and insert "degree granting colleges at" after transfer students entering," to read:

"I move that transfer students entering degree granting colleges at Wichita State University during the summer session, 1975, and the academic year 1975-1976 not be subject to the 8 hour General Studies requirement."

Mr. Jakowatz seconded.

b. Mr. Paske moved to strike "degree granting colleges" from the amendment and insert, "with junior standing" to read:

"I move that transfer students entering Wichita State University with junior standing..."

Mr. Greenberg seconded.

After further discussion, the motion was made to close debate. The motion passed. Mr. Paske's amendment (b) was brought to a vote. The amendment failed.

The previous question was called and debate was closed. Mr. Wix's amendment (a) was called. The motion carried.

c. Mr. Paske moved to delete in Amendment a, "not be subject to the 8 hour General Studies requirement." and substitute, "be subject to no more than 3 hours of General Studies courses to be taken outside the college in which he has enrolled." to read:

"I move that transfer students entering degree granting colleges at Wichita State University during the summer session, 1975, and the academic year 1975-1976 be subject to no more than 3 hours of General Studies courses to be taken outside the college in which he is enrolled."

The motion was seconded.

d. Ms. Millett moved to add as a substitute for Mr. Paske's amendment (c), "but shall be strongly encouraged to take advantage of the opportunity to take General Studies courses." To read as follows:

"I move that transfer students entering degree granting colleges at Wichita State University during the summer session, 1975, and the academic year 1975-1976 not be subject to the 8 hour General Studies requirement, but shall be strongly encouraged to take advantage of the opportunity to take General Studies courses."

The motion was seconded. Mr. Paske moved the question and debate was closed. The motion (d) passed by voice vote.

Ms. Burgess moved the previous question, Section B, as amended. The motion was seconded and carried, debate being closed. The motion to approve Section B as amended passed. The Chair announced that the motion as amended would go to the General Faculty.

Section C was moved, seconded, and passed.

Mr. Perel suggested that the committee look into the feasibility of granting credit for courses from other institutions as satisfies the Wichita State University General Studies requirement. The chair stated that the request would be passed on to the committee.

Ms. Millett moved to delete, "in no case later than" from Section D and add "and that such action will have been taken prior to November 15 in the fall semester of 1975," to read:

"Finally, I move that further action regarding implementation of the General Studies requirement for transfer students be delayed until the Ad Hoc committee can report back to the University Senate, for further Senate discussion and action, and that such action will have been taken prior to November 15 in the fall semester of 1975."

The motion was seconded and passed.

Mr. Paske moved that the Committee named in Section C also study the relationship between the Community College Transfer and Articulation Agreement and the University General Education Requirements. The motion was seconded and passed.

It was moved to pass Section D as amended. The motion passed.

Ms. Millett moved to accept the entire package. Debate was closed. The entire package was accepted as amended.

Ms. Froning requested that the committee be asked to consider dropping the General Studies courses as requirements and urging WSU students to take General Studies courses. The Chair stated that the request would be passed on to the committee

The remaining portions of the General Studies Report was brought to the floor for consideration.

Mr. Rogers moved to accept, without debate, Items II, III, and IV, of the report. The motion was seconded.

Ms. Burgess suggested that the committee consider the effect that prerequisites on General Studies courses might have in discouraging students from enrolling in the courses. She recommended that the courses be structured so that students are able to take them as early as possible.

Ms. Stephens agreed and indicated that she thought that only one General Studies course had prerequisites at the present time and that caution would be maintained in specifying prerequisites for future courses.

The question was called, and the General Studies report ( Sections II, III, and IV) was accepted.

The motion was made to endorse the letter to Governor Bennett from the State Faculty Senate Presidents seeking a change in the law that requires biweekly payroll for unclassified employees. The Senate voted to endorse the letter.
