RECOMMENDATIONS FROM SENATE COMMITTEES
Spring, 1972

Public Occasions Committee

The committee recommends that some sort of guidelines for declaring a convocation be given to the committee by either the University Senate or the University administration.

Library Committee

The committee recommends that subsequent Library Committees continue to study with the Director of Libraries the effect of the application of loan policies and, as needed, to suggest modifications.

University Traffic Policy Committee

The committee recommends that the court cost of one dollar be continued.

Financial Aids and Scholarship Committee

The committee recommends the addition of two more members.

Curriculum Committee

The committee recommends that the format for new program proposals be accepted.

Continuing Education Committee

The committee has recommended that W. S. U. revise its policy to allow up to thirty hours of credit toward a degree in extension and/or independent study.

Tenure and Welfare Committee

The committee completed a set of recommendations on appeals procedures. It is planned to send these recommendations to the Senate for action in the very near future.

The following Committees submitted no recommendations:

Teacher Education Council, Court of Student Academic Appeals, Honors, Military Affairs, Student-Faculty Relations, Traffic Court, Athletic, Admissions and Exceptions, Research and Publications, Summer School.
