Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

The BYOD (“bring-your-own-device”) classroom is the least built-out, but still enables faculty to teach with their own laptops, tablets, or phones as desired.

Standard Features: Connection to plug in a user-provided full-size HDMI or VGA+Audio cable for user’s laptop/tablet/phone, etc., wireless presentation. Also includes projector or display of appropriate size, plus appropriate speaker coverage for voice and video playback, with push-button controls. Part of Campus Media Services’ managed AV system.

Optional Features: Additional mirrored displays/projectors. Current Examples: Hubbard Hall 342, Old Town (213) A112, WSU Haysville 115-123.
