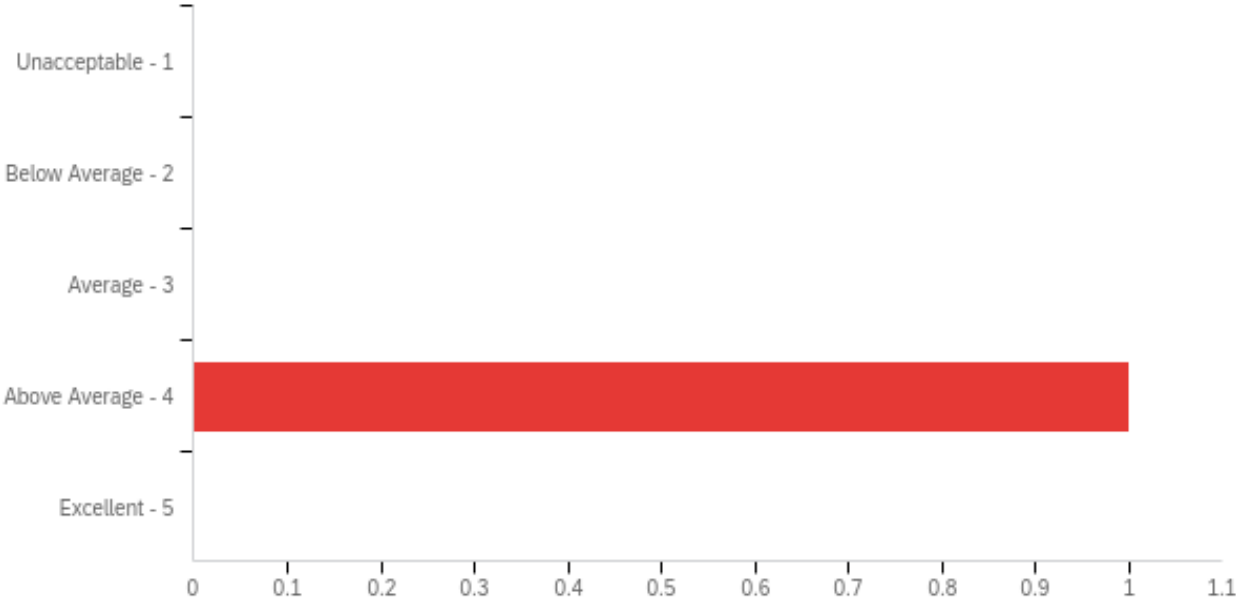

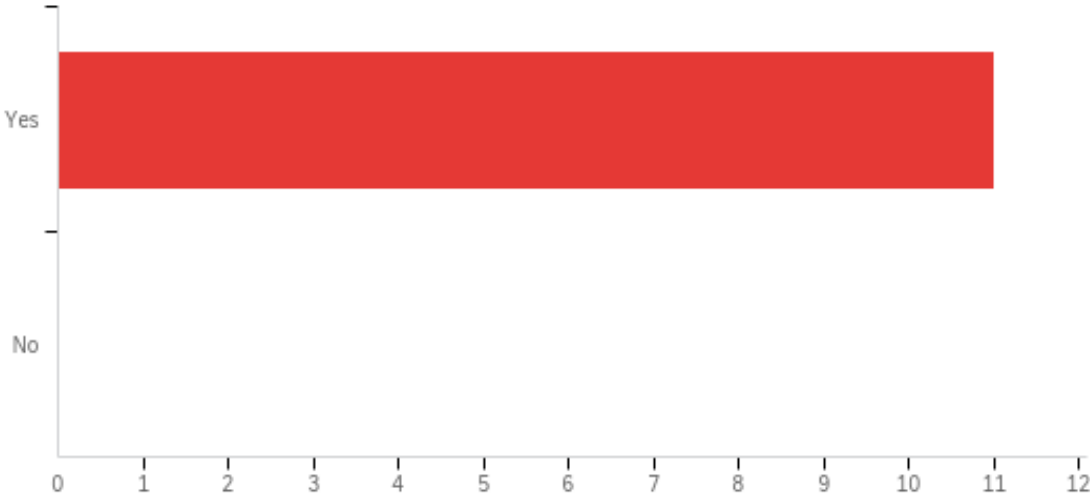

Talks w/ people at the info tables. These should have been promoted better. There was no one else visiting the tables.

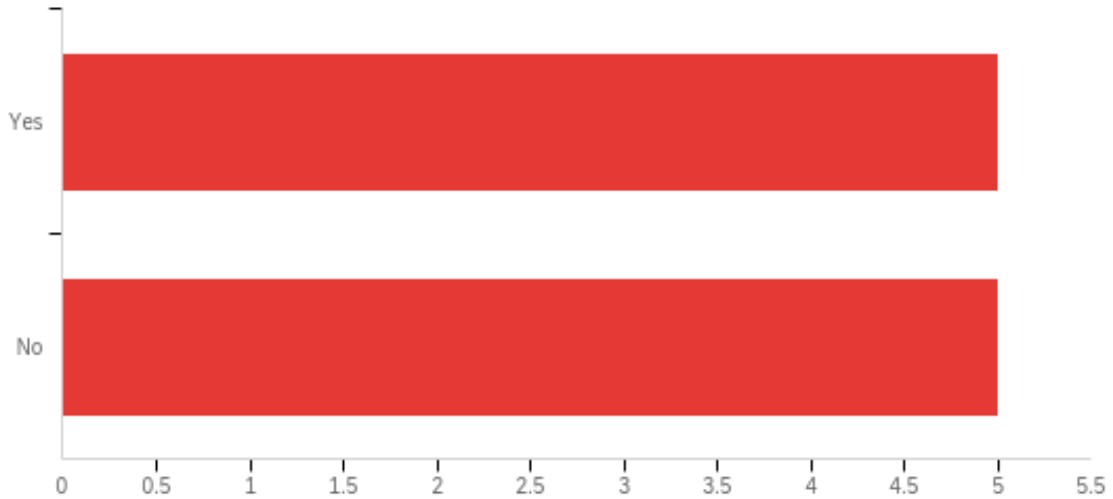

The sessions were nice this time but I actually think a tour option in the morning would have been great. Instructors/advisors want to SEE the school/programs.

*Know the correct name of your partner schools; Don't assume/imply 2 year colleges don't understand transferability; Provide validation for parking in garage. (KU & KSU do!) *Know your audience- much said was about students who are not part of a community college.

Make information tables more accessible, maybe placed in lobby where students and advisors have to pass by

Am a little bothered by out-dated terminology of "Junior College"- Our role in the state is not as a "Jr"- we train & are equivalent for course rigor, offerings & programs. The breakout sessions need to be more focused on the transfer process -specifically- we don't need inspirational or PD topics. We want specifics on the transfer process. Explain how the orientation process works. What Career Services connections are available? Obviously need to promote Dual Advising more.

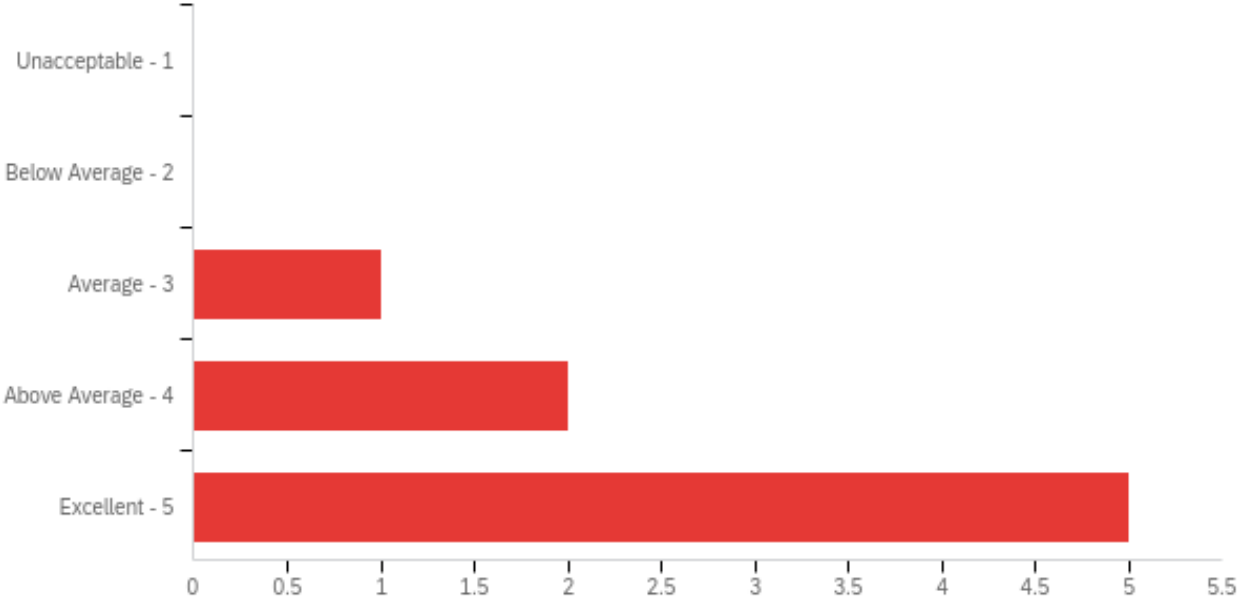

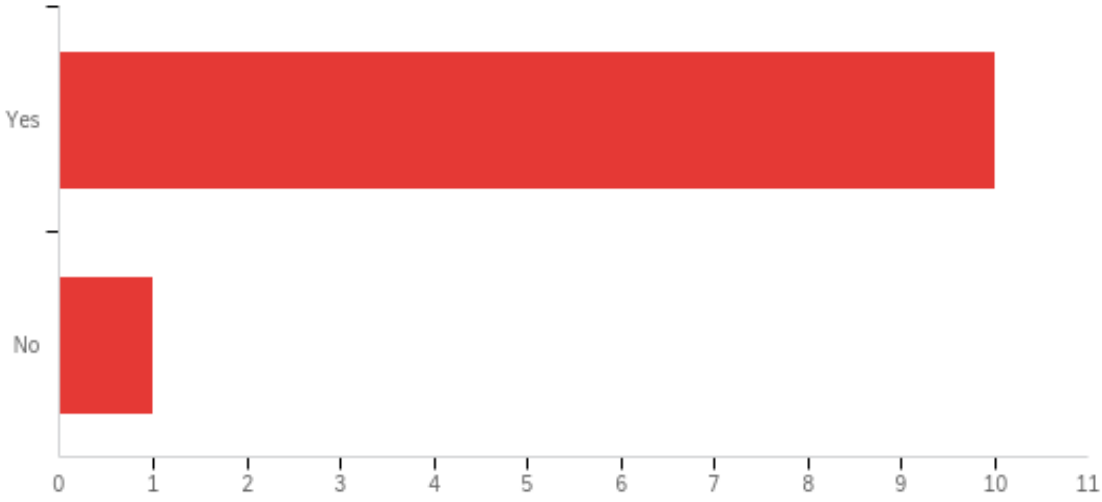

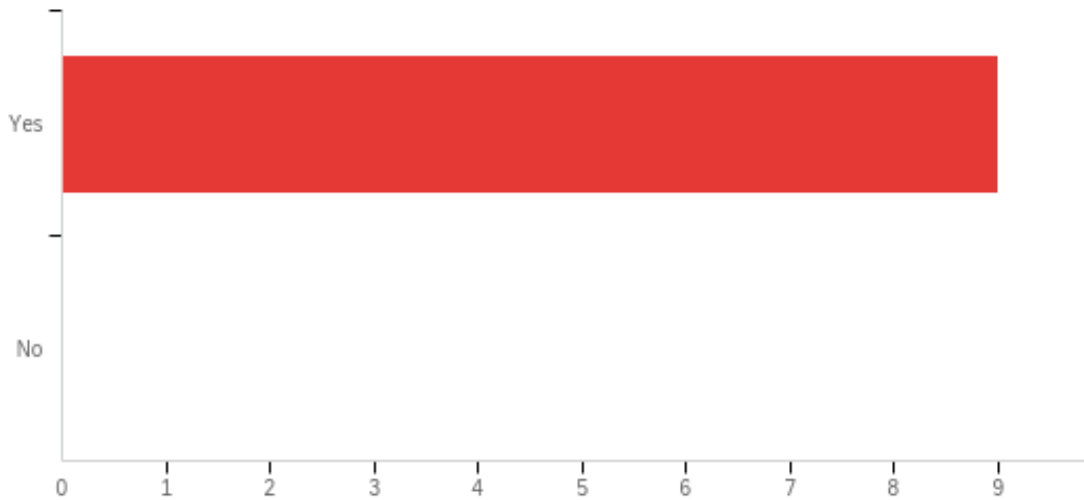
Transferring to WSU is not as bad as it sounds

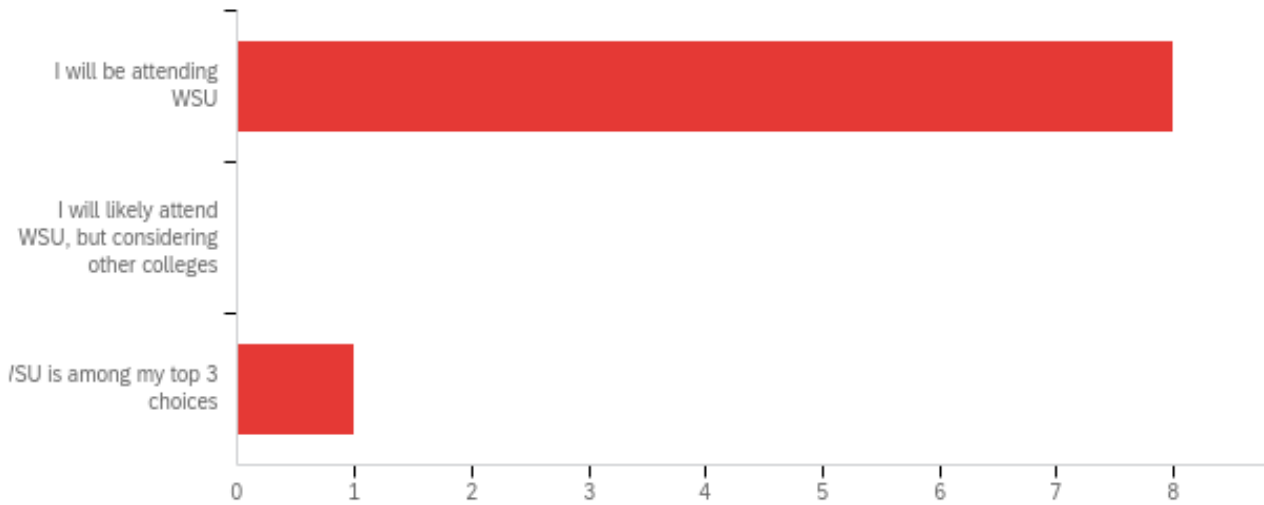
- Making connections and networking.
