At a meeting of the Board of Trustees of Fairmount College held on the 25th day of March 1911, the following action was taken:

"Moved, that we make a contract with the Presbyterian authorities of the State of Kansas to turn over control of the College through its Board of Trustees upon the following conditions.

1. That all the debts be paid, including the grant from the Congregational Education Society as well as all other debts.
2. That the name be retained.
3. That Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) of cash or of interest bearing securities equivalent to cash be given to Fairmount College for endowment purposes only by Tuesday of Fairmount Commencement week for the year 1911, and that until such conditions are complied with the College be continued and operated as heretofore, and that a committee be appointed consisting of Landergin, Darling, Stevens, Bort and Holmes for the purpose of making a contract to that effect."
