MEMORANDUM TO COLONEL GOETHALS:

Robert F. Fredericks, Zone Police No. 93, is used as a bailiff at the Criminal Court, Cristobal. He does not report to the Police Station at any time. He is hardly ever in uniform. As a rule, the Court only meets one day in a week, and the hours are nine until eleven, and two until four. At other times, I am informed, he attends to Judge Collins' mail, and other personal matters of his. According to this, some weeks this bailiff is only on actual duty four hours.

If you desire, I may obtain proof as to actual personal work he does for Judge Collins. My reason for not doing so already is, that if I went any farther in the matter, it would become known.
