<b>Call to order</b> Whitney Bailey	3:30 pm	
<b>Informal statements and proposals</b>	Senator Billingham noted the history of his advocacy of the importance of market-based compensation for faculty. President Bailey noted that Provost Lefever would address these questions during the President’s Report portion of the meeting.	
<b>Approval of minutes</b>	<u><a href="#">April 25, 2022</a></u>	MSC
<b>President's Report</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• KBOR has not met in May. Senators are encouraged to review the <u><a href="#">agenda and minutes for future meetings</a></u>. Bailey will continue to serve through June, accompanied by Castro.</li><li>• KBOR is reviewing the policy on program reviews. The faculty advisory committee includes Bailey, Provost Lefever, AVP GlenMaye.</li><li>• Provost Lefever notes that of the 1718 benefits-eligible employees 1053 are below the median wage. The outcomes of the pay analysis showed there were not systemic bias in pay of race or gender. Base pay adjustments will be made in FY23 with the goal of moving individuals below 80% of the median to closer to 80% of the median. The state is giving \$2.5M and WSU is planning \$2M for the first year. When asked about RU funded positions, Lefever notes that this is GU only. Information for RU funded positions will be told what the target salary should be, and supervisors are asked to communicate with deans to do the best they can for those positions. Senators noted that 80% of the median is below the 25<sup>th</sup> percentile in many cases and requested that the documented salary spread across campus, or at least across college be made available so that faculty can fight for faculty pay. Provost Lefever noted that she hoped the document would be available.</li><li>• Legislative update – after the final veto session, the legislature did not give full funding requested for higher education, and as a result, KBOR is open to tuition increase requests. WSU will be asking for a 1.1% increase.</li></ul>

<b>Proposed Academic Integrity Policy Committee</b>	<a href="#">Proposed Academic Integrity Policy Committee</a> President Bailey presented the rationale behind forming this new committee. Senator Billingham asked if there are other, similar policies that the Faculty Senate has oversight over that could be served with this committee, and President Bailey will look into this and work with President-Elect Castro to revise and expand the charges of this committee if needed. Senator Allen motions to suspend the rules to vote on this proposal after one read (second Ross). The motion to suspend the rules passes by unanimous voice vote.	Motion to approve the proposal (Bowen; second Small). Vote via Zoom poll passes 31 to 1.
