## **Mission Critical Undergraduate Program Review Process and Principles**

Programs deemed to be mission critical at WSU reflect our three priorities of 1) access and affordability, 2) developing the talent pipeline, and 3) economic prosperity. The applied learning requirement in every degree program ensures students go beyond acquiring requisite knowledge and skills and are able to understand, analyze, and contribute to the social, cultural, and economic well-being of our city and our region – thus advancing our vision to be an urban public research university known for providing impactful applied learning experiences.

Our focus on applied learning has led to numerous partnerships with industry on our Innovation Campus and in the community and has taken many other forms, including engaging students with digital literacy in the refugee community and involving students in supporting the high concentration of arts in our city that, which research has shown leads to higher civic engagement, more social cohesion, higher child welfare, and lower poverty rates.

As with any decision, we consider our existing resources with these priorities to determine what programs are phased out, merged or placed on an action plan.
