My dear friends,

In order that you, as American citizens, may be prepared for any emergency I desire to call your attention to the present acute international situation which may result in war in Europe. The Legation has no definite information to the effect that hostilities will break out but the situation is very uncertain and disturbing.

The Legation will try to communicate with you immediately in the event of an emergency and in the meantime I would suggest that you give some thought to the possibility of evacuation and if you have made any plans to return to the United States within the near future it might be well for you to carry out those plans as soon as possible as a precautionary measure since transportation facilities from this area would be greatly restricted if not entirely eliminated in the event of war.
