Dear Auntie -

Upon opening a book a few days ago, I accidentally discovered a letter that I supposed I had sent to you a long time ago - You can judge of my surprise when I discovered the contrary - But I trust that it will prove to you that my intentions are good, although they do not always appear so - I handed it to Mrs. Gay and told her to read it and then throw into the fire - she replied that I had better write some more and send it away - I concluded that I would follow her advice and add my postscript - Our "eastern friends" are still
