I. CALL TO ORDER

President Perel called to order the last meeting of the 1978-1979 University Senate at 3:45 p.m.

II. INFORMAL PROPOSALS AND STATEMENTS

President Perel thanked the officers of the Senate and the members of the Agenda Committee for their contributions during the past year.

President Perel announced that the Student Senate resolution regarding traffic problems at the corner of 21st Street and Hillside, passed by the University Senate on April 9, 1979, has been sent to the Wichita Traffic Commission. He pointed out that there will be an open meeting of the Traffic Commission to consider this matter on May 16.

President Perel discussed the significance and value of University governance and participation in University governance.

President Perel pointed out that there has been some input into the budget process by members of the faculty and by the University Senate.

MOTION

Senator Dreifort thanked President Perel for his accomplishments during his year in office and moved that the Senate commend President Perel for his activities as University Senate President. The motion was seconded by President Ahlberg.

VOTE

The motion was passed unanimously.

Senator Thomann stated that the letters he had recently written to the Sunflower pointed out that individual faculty members really have very little input into the budgetary process.

President Ahlberg noted that, for the Senate or the faculty to have impact on the budgetary process, they must accomplish these actions during the fall semester.

The minutes of the meeting of May 7, 1979 were approved.

Senator Graham commended President Perel for his performance as University Senate President.
