Dear Sir-

After leaving you I went straight through to Iaconda - which I found was a very thriving - money plenty and business of all kinds seemed to be in a thrifty condition - Real property changing hands rapidly at a good figure - I invested in some acre property near the city which I think will prove a good investment - just returned to Dak and have settled down to business on the road where I think I shall remain for a while - I think Dak is coming to the front now as an agricultural country - every year shows a great improvement over the previous year -

I have heard nothing from Oklahoma since I left - nor see nothing in the
