Washington. July 1 1866

Dear Sir,

I have not received a letter from you since I received a short one written at Frankfurt. I have written you three letters at Rio but you may not have received any of them.

Mr. Foy says that the Government will be ordered here so as to reach the United States about the first of next November, so you may make your arrangements accordingly.

We have nothing new of either a general or domestic nature to write about. We have not heard from Mrs. Pickens for two or three weeks. Yours much
