The 21st New York Volunteers Cavalry was organized at Troy, N. Y., from August to October, 1863, with William Tibbits, Colonel, Charles Fitzsimmons, Lieutenant Colonel, Charles Otis and George Boutell, Majors, and served in the Department of Washington, 22nd Corps to January, 1864; 1st Brigade, 1st Division, Department of West Virginia to April, 1864; 1st Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division, Department of West Virginia to October, 1864; 1st Brigade, 2nd Division Cavalry, Army of the Shenandoah, Department of West Virginia, Middle Military Division to September, 1865; and 1st Separate Cavalry Brigade, Department of the Missouri and Military Division of the Mississippi to August, 1866.
